Adverse drug reactions are a leading cause of death

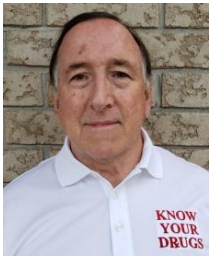

Angela Bischoff, a suicide survivor, will be facilitating the discussion. Her partner of 17 years - Tooker Gomberg - died by suicide in 2004, shortly after beginning an antidepressant which agitated him.



David Carmichael started speaking out about prescription drug safety in 2006, two years after taking the life of his 11-year-old son Ian when he became psychotic shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil. He was charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible and spent years institutionalized under the law. David manages the Know Your

Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for Vanessa's Law, and is currently on a cross-Canada tour. Before the discussion, he will be delivering the presentation:
