Joelle Richardson will be facilitating the discussion. She is a critical thinking social worker, who has practiced in Calgary for more than a decade. Joelle advocates for informed consent and for open dialogue between individuals and the systems that are meant to support them, and believes that it is essential for these systems to be transparent.



David Carmichael experienced psychosis in 2004, shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil, and took the life of his 11-year-old son, Ian. He was then charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible and institutionalized. David manages the Know Your Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for Vanessa's Law, and is currently on a cross-Canada tour.
