David Carmichael experienced psychosis in 2004, shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil, and took the life of his 11-year-old son, Ian. He was then charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible and institutionalized. David manages the Know Your Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for Vanessa's Law.
