David Zitner, a retired Professor at Dalhousie University and retired family physician, will be facilitating the discussion. He was the founding director of the graduate program in Health Informatics in the Faculty of Medicine at Dalhousie University, and has many publications in peer reviewed journals and the popular press.



David Carmichael experienced psychosis in 2004, shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil, and took the life of his 11-year-old son, Ian. He was then charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible and institutionalized. David manages the Know Your Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for Vanessa's Law. This public discussion is the Eastern Canada regional launch of his cross-Canada tour, which will end on June 23, 2022 in Victoria, British Columbia.
