David Carmichael experienced psychosis in 2004, shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil, and took the life of his 11-year-old son, Ian. He was then charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible and institutionalized. David manages the Know Your Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for

Vanessa's Law. This will be the last public discussion in his cross-Canada tour, which started on September 14, 2021 in Halifax, Nova Scotia. Before the discussion, he will be delivering the presentation:
