David Carmichael experienced psychosis in July 2004, shortly after starting the antidepressant Paxil, and took the life of his 11-year-old son, Ian. He was then charged with first-degree murder, judged not criminally responsible, and institutionalized. David manages the Know Your Drugs global awareness campaign as Executive Director of the charitable organization Canadians for Vanessa's Law. His family tragedy was the basis for the CTV W5 episode “The Problem with Pills,” which aired on October 9, 2021. This public discussion will launch his cross-Canada tour, which will end in Victoria, British Columbia on June 23, 2022. Before the discussion, David will be delivering the presentation:
